TERMS AND CONDITIONS

REGISTRATION & HEALTH: All animals, except market, are registered. Transfer of registration papers will be handled by Sale Management Service after the sale, unless Consigner requests to transfer. Consigners must provide registration and two copies of health papers for each lot during check-in. Health papers will be provided on sale day to the new owner upon complete payment of the sheep.

SHIPPING: Each consigner will be responsible for shipping arrangements of sheep purchased on order.

ENTRY SUBSTITUTIONS: A bar beneath the number painted on the animal's back designates that it is a substitute entry, meaning the information about the animal is different than designated in the catalog. Check with the consigner for complete pedigree information.

NOTICE: Neither sale management, sale sponsors nor consigners to the sale assume any risk or liability in case of accidents of any kind or losses of any kind to any person or persons in attendance at the sale or show.

TERMS: Cash, Check or Credit Card. All purchases are to be settled with the clerks immediately following the sale and before the sheep are removed from the premises. MasterCard, Visa, Discover or American Express will be the only accepted methods of credit card payment. A 4% convenience fee will be charged for credit card payment. The auctioneer's decision is final on any disputed bids. \$350 minimum on lambs. \$400 minimum on yearlings. All animals are at purchaser's risk as soon as sold. A \$20 buy back fee applies to all consigners. A 20% surcharge will be assessed to any insufficient-fund checks issued. Buyer shall be responsible for any and all costs of collection, including attorney's fees. Institutions may pay by requisition. Foreign buyers must pay in U.S. funds. Registration papers will not be transferred to the new owner until paid in full.

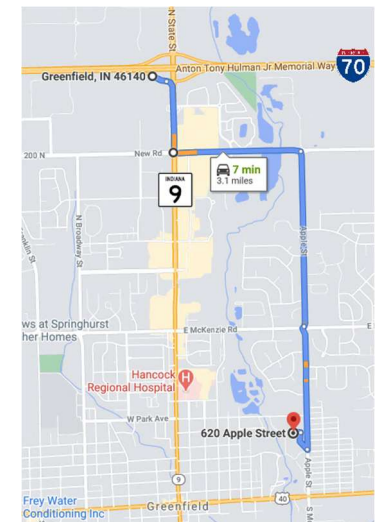


Directions
